WHAT OUR PROGRAMS OFFER

Treatment is individualized and tailored to each person's unique needs. Patients interact daily with staff to identify personal struggles associated with their individual diagnosis, help formulate their own treatment plan and determine short term goals designed just for them.

Our ultimate goal is to provide a solid foundation of support and clinical expertise in the safest environment possible before transitioning patients back into the community as they pursue the next phase of their recovery, healing and overall wellness in an outpatient setting of their choice.

Our programs are designed to treat individuals challenged with psychiatric disorders such as:

- Anxiety
- Depressive illness
- Post-traumatic stress disorders
- Personality disorders

Treatment focuses on dysfunctional behaviors and emotional problems which may result from:

- Serious depression
- Sexual abuse
- Self-mutilation
- Suicidal behavior
- Trauma

TREATMENT TEAMS

Led by our psychiatrist, the treatment team uses an evidence based approach of cognitive behavioral, psychodynamic, systemic and family therapy modalities. When appropriate, medications are used in conjunction with other therapy.

CHILDREN'S SERVICES

Treating children up to age 12, our program utilizes a variety of approaches to help children overcome emotional and behavioral challenges. Under the direction of a child/adolescent psychiatrist, our treatment team provides evidence based educational and behavioral modification programs that are age appropriate and designed for continued use in the home.

ADOLESCENT SERVICES

Our Adolescent program has been developed for 13-17 year olds who are experiencing behavioral and emotional problems, sometimes complicated by alcohol and drug use. We work closely with families and referring professionals to develop treatment plans for each teen's specific challenge. Education is provided by a state certified teacher, allowing each teen to complete their academic curriculum and maintain contact with his or her home school during their stay.

CO-OCCURRING SERVICES

We specialize in treatment for persons who have psychiatric illnesses that coexist with chemical addictions. Our co-occurring program is designed to provide tailored therapies that can effectively treat the psychiatric disorder and break the cycle of addiction.



INTAKE REFERRAL PROCESS

We accept admissions 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Calling our toll-free number, 1.800.456.2634, will connect you with an admissions counselor who will work with the referring professional or family member to determine the most appropriate level of care. If hospitalization is needed, transportation services can be arranged.

It is our goal to provide effective communication with each patient's family, referring professional and agency. Although family participation is not required, we encourage it whenever possible. Our discharge plan includes referral back to a community professional, when available, along with other community support programs.
