- Receives Food Stamps

- Receives housing assistance
- Receives Veteran benefits

Patients with MoHealthNet

If you are a patient that has MoHealthNet, Home State Health, Missouri Care, or United Healthcare Community Plan you might qualify for the following transportation services:

MTM

866-269-5927



- Must have MoHealthNet
- Schedule ride at least three(3) business days before appointment, but can call up to 30 days in advance

Home State Health

855-694-4663



home state health.

- Must call at least three(3) days before your appointment, same day transportation may be available for primary care appointments at least one-hour before appointment
- No cost to ride

Missouri Care

- Must call at least three(3) days before your appointment to schedule
- No cost to ride

UnitedHealthcare Community Plan

- Must have United Healthcare Community Plan
- Must call at least three(3) days before your appointment to schedule
- No cost to ride

MoHealthNet Gas Reimbursement

- Must have MoHealthNet, Home State Health, Missouri Care, or United Healthcare Community Plan
- Log mileage to and from appointments to receive gas reimbursement
- Trips must be approved in advance
- Logs can be found online

- Eligibility is determined by application completed by patient and medical or mental health provider

Services for Independent Living

Transportation (SIL)

- Must be 55 and older or disabled
- First time riders must call and complete an intake process
- Schedule ride at least two (2) weeks before appointment due to limited availability
- \$2.00 for every stop within city limits
- \$3.00 for stops outside of city limits
- \$5.00 for stops county to county

- From Ashland, Hallsville, Centralia, Harrisburg, Rocheport and Sturgeon to Columbia on the 2nd and 4th Monday each month
- Bus runs Monday-Friday: 8:30a.m. - 4:30p.m.
- Medical appointments must be made between the hours of 10a.m. to 2p.m. to ensure transportation home
- Fares (One-Way):
 - In – Town: \$2.00
 - Within County: \$3.00
 - Adjacent County: \$4.00
 - Long Distance (beyond two counties): \$3.00 per county

Voluntary Action Center

- Vouchers may be provided once every 30 days based on funding limits.
- Vouchers are available to request up to 5 business days before scheduled health appointments or work dates.
- Assistance to patients who live in Boone County
- Help with bus tickets and gas to appointments and work
- Call first to see what information they require to assess your eligibility assistance
