Patients with MoHealthNet

If you are a patient that has MoHealthNet, Home State Health, Missouri Care, or United Healthcare Community Plan you might qualify for the following transportation services:

MTM

- Must have MoHealthNet
- Schedule ride at least three(3) business days before appointment, but can call up to 30 days in advance

Home State Health

- Must call at least three(3) days before your appointment, same day transportation may be available for primary care appointments at least one-hour before appointment
- No cost to ride

Missouri Care

- Must call at least three(3) days before your appointment to schedule
- No cost to ride

- Must have United Healthcare Community Plan
- Must call at least three(3) days before your appointment to schedule
- No cost to ride

MoHealthNet Gas Reimbursement

- Must have MoHealthNet, Home State Health, Missouri Care, or United Healthcare Community Plan
- Log mileage to and from appointments to receive gas reimbursement
- Trips must be approved in advance
- Logs can be found online

- Open: 24/7; Offers door-to-door rides for any purpose for older adults (65+) or disabled persons. Must become a member to ride; call for application; annual rate \$50 for person or \$75 for family.

- Free service that connects people in need of transportation assistance with available providers in their community. Helping People connect to transportation providers 24/7. Services available statewide. Serves General Public. (whether needing a ride to the doctor, grocery store, employment, or any other purpose.)
- Need to call between hrs 8-4:30 to arrange rides 24/7

- Open: 9am - 4 pm I-70 route runs 5am - 7pm M-F; Fees: \$0.50 for ages 6-62 and \$0.25 for ages 62+ or with Medicaid card. Serves the City of St Charles & goes to Metrolink North Hanley Station. Anyone wishing to be picked up or dropped off a fixed/deviation route must call 24-hrs in advance.

- I-70 to Warrenton Route:
 - Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday
 - Warren County residents with origins within 3 miles of I-70 to Warrenton
- Service to Warrenton:
 - Every Wednesday
 - Appointments must be scheduled between the hours of 10:00a.m. and 2:00p.m.
- Service to Washington:
 - 3rd Thursday each month
 - Appointments must be scheduled between the hours of 10:00a.m. and 2:00p.m.
- Fares (One-Way):
 - In - Town: \$2.00
 - Within County: \$3.00
 - Adjacent County: \$4.00
 - Long Distance (beyond two counties): \$3.00 per count
