

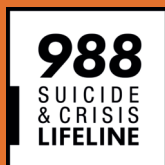


Youth BHUC

The Youth Behavioral Health Urgent Care is open seven (7) days a week from 9:00am-9:00pm for youth ages 5-17 who are experiencing a behavioral health, emotional disturbance or substance use related crisis.

- Services include crisis stabilization, medication management, clinical assessment, brief therapy, and connection to ongoing community-based services and resources.
- Parents/Guardians must be present for services.
- Services are provided at no charge to customers with Medicaid, uninsured/underinsured. Some co-pays may apply for commercially insured customers.

YOUTH 5 - 17 YEARS OLD
EXPERIENCING AN
INTENSE EMOTIONAL
STATE:

(PARENT OR GUARDIAN MUST BE PRESENT)

- Thoughts of suicide, harming self or others
- Angry/aggressive behavior outbursts
- Using or experimenting with substances
- Seeing or hearing things that others don't see or hear
- Needs psychiatric medication refill or initial evaluation for psychiatric medications

OUR YOUTH BEHAVIORAL HEALTH URGENT CARE IS OPEN 9:00 AM TO 9:00 PM/7 DAYS A WEEK TO YOUTH WHO ARE IN NEED OF IMMEDIATE ASSISTANCE DEALING WITH A MENTAL HEALTH OR SUBSTANCE USE CRISIS. THE YBHUC IS A VOLUNTARY PROGRAM.
