Do you have a PAD?

- A psychiatric advance directive (PAD) is a legal document that documents a person's preferences for future mental health treatment and allows appointment of a health proxy to interpret those preferences during a crisis. PADs are used when a person becomes unable to make decisions during a mental health crisis.

Compass Health Crisis Line

- Compass Health Crisis Line covers 26 counties across Missouri.
- We have Crisis Line Clinicians available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, including holidays.
- Crisis Line assists callers of any age. Can be reached by dialing 988 or 888.237.4567. *In Missouri, if you live in Boone, Chariton, Linn, Randolph, Pettis, or St. Louis County, please call 636-283-2737.*
- Clinicians are trained in de-escalation, risk assessment, safety planning, and care coordination.
- The crisis line can dispatch a Mobile Crisis Clinician to a caller's location if needed.
- You don't have to be a Compass Health client and are not required to become one to utilize the Crisis Line.
- The Crisis Line is Free of charge.
- We can follow up with clients in need of extra support in the evenings, weekends, or over the holidays.

- Mobile Crisis Response Clinicians are available 24/7/365 and provide immediate person-centered assistance both virtually or in person
- Available to respond to any behavioral health and/or substance use crisis

- Survivor of Suicide Attempt Support

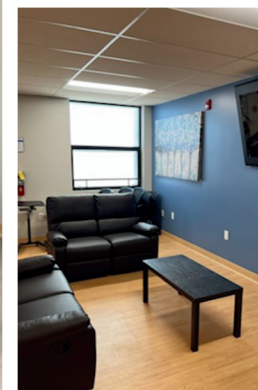
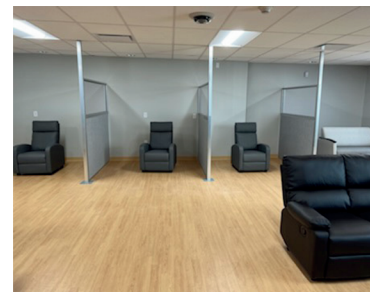
