

# BRINGING CARE TO THOSE IN NEED... SUPPORTING OUR COMMUNITIES.

The goal of the Behavioral Health Crisis Center is to provide a safe and less costly alternative to the system by diverting individuals from the emergency room and jail during a behavioral health crisis. These services allow for crisis intervention, observation, and stabilization while further working to connect the individual into ongoing treatment and care, and avoiding an inpatient admission.

## **ACCESS TO CARE-**

The crisis centers are 24/7/365, "no wrong door entry" program that provides rapid access to triage, stabilization services, and linkage to appropriate community services for individuals experiencing a behavioral health crisis.

### **OUR TEAM**

Our staff - a multi-disciplinary team that includes nurses, case workers, mental health technicians, behavioral health clinicians, and psychiatrists/nurse practitioners.

#### **RESOURCES**-

The crisis center works in collaboration with local social service providers to develop needed resources and enhance the existing system of care.

#### WHO WE SERVE -

Adults, 18 and over, who are underserved, underinsured, and uninsured, and are dealing with a mental health or substance use crisis. The Youth Behavioral Health Urgent Care serves ages 5 through 17.
