The goal of the Behavioral Health Crisis Center is to provide a safe and less costly alternative to the system by diverting individuals from the emergency room and jail during a behavioral health crisis. These services allow for crisis intervention, observation, and stabilization while further working to connect the individual into ongoing treatment and care, and avoiding an inpatient admission.

ACCESS TO CARE

The crisis centers are 24/7/365, "no wrong door entry" program that provides rapid access to triage, stabilization services, and linkage to appropriate community services for individuals experiencing a behavioral health crisis.

OUR TEAM

Our staff – a multi-disciplinary team that includes nurses, case workers, mental health technicians, behavioral health clinicians, and psychiatrists/nurse practitioners.

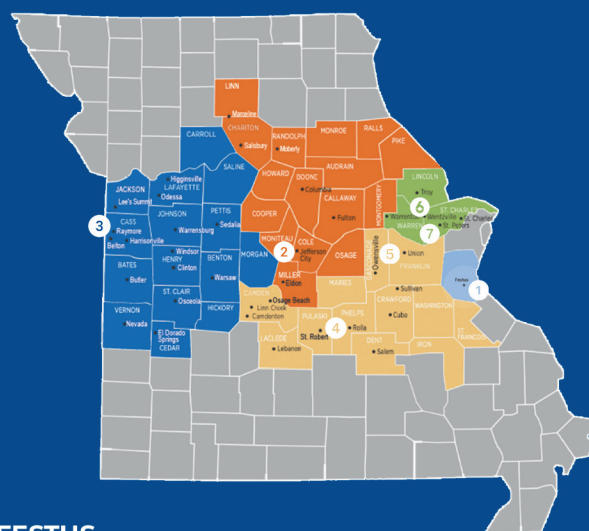
RESOURCES
