Health Care Home is an initiative to improve patient access to healthcare and improve communications among medical teams. Health Care Home aims to assist patients in managing chronic health conditions, promoting healthy lifestyles as well as providing follow up to hospitalizations. In some cases, our team may be able to prevent hospitalization all together.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

This might be the best part — it costs you nothing! Health Care Home is a program funded through Missouri Healthnet. As long as you maintain Missouri Healthnet, you can continue to utilize Health Care Home.

WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN HEALTH CARE HOME AND HOME HEALTH SERVICES?

Home Health is a service provided in your own residence, with frequent visits from a nurse, nursing assistant and other medical professionals as appropriate. Healthcare Home services is a support team in your Primary Care office to help you manage your Chronic Health conditions. We supply patients with various means of support by meeting with the patient in our office regularly to discuss any needs of the patient.

WHAT DO I GET WITH THIS PROGRAM?

You will have access to different medical staff to support your health journey. Health Care Home Directors, Nurse Case Managers, Behavioral Health Consultants and Program Care Coordinators work closely to ensure that patients are supported in their medical conditions from a wellness approach that looks at the whole person, not just a specific symptom or need.
